

DID YOU KNOW?

THERE'S A NEW OIL & GLYCOL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Program starts January 2020. Accepted items will be banned from landfill March 1, 2020.

ACCEPTED ITEMS:



Oils: Petroleum or synthetic derived crankcase oil, engine oil and gear oil, hydraulic fluid, transmission fluid and heat transfer fluid, and fluid used for lubricating machinery or equipment.



Filters: Spin-on style or element style fluid filters used in hydraulic, transmission or internal combustion engines, oil filters, diesel fuel filters, storage tank fuel filters, household furnace oil filters other than gasoline filters.



Oil, glycol and DEF containers: Containers with a capacity up to 50 litres for holding oil, glycol or DEF product.



Aerosol containers: Aerosol containers for holding oil products and aerosol containers for products used to clean automotive parts.



Glycol (antifreeze): Ethylene or propylene glycol for vehicle or commercial engine coolant. *Does not include:* plumbing antifreeze, windshield washer antifreeze, lock de-icer, gasoline and diesel fuel antifreeze.
